Attorney Anthony J. Jurek filed a no-merit report pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.32(1) on behalf of defendant-appellant, Andrew Meinholz, in the court of appeals. On March 31, 2015, the court of appeals summarily affirmed the judgment of conviction and relieved Attorney Jurek of further representation. On April 30, 2015, Attorney Jurek filed a motion seeking a ruling on the competency of Andrew Meinholz. On May 14, 2015, this court construed that motion as a timely but nonconforming petition for review. On December 2, 2015, this court remanded the matter to the Dane County circuit court for a determination of postconviction competency. Attorney Jurek was appointed to represent Andrew Meinholz in the circuit court proceedings on remand. On May 25, 2016, Attorney Jurek informed the court that the circuit court determined that Andrew Meinholz is not competent to exercise his right to file a statement in support of a petition for review.
