You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2013AP2732-CRNM State v. Meinholz L.C.#2010CF1226

Attorney Anthony J. Jurek filed a no-merit report pursuant to Rule 809.32(1) in the court of appeals. Defendant-appellant, Andrew Meinholz, was informed of his right to file a response but no response was filed. On March 31, 2015, the court of appeals summarily affirmed the judgment of conviction and relieved Attorney Jurek of further representation.

On April 30, 2015, Attorney Jurek filed a motion for a ruling on defendant-appellant's competency. The motion was filed in the court of appeals, but has been referred to this court. In the motion, Attorney Jurek states he wishes to preserve defendant-appellant's right to file a petition for review. This court has construed the motion as a nonconforming petition for review.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition shall be deemed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review.
