No. 2023XX1346-D Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Osman A. Mirza

On October 30, 2023, this court granted the Office of Lawyer Regulation's (OLR) motion seeking the summary suspension of Attorney Osman A. Mirza's license to practice law pursuant to SCR 22.20. The order temporarily suspended Attorney Mirza's license as of the date of the order and until further order of this court. The order additionally directed Attorney Mirza to comply with the requirements of SCR 22.26 relating to license suspension.

On November 3, 2023, Attorney Mirza filed a "Memorandum and Motion for Leave to Comply with SCR 22.26." In the motion, Attorney Mirza states that because he received the summary suspension order after its immediate effective date, "it is impossible to comply with [SCR 22.26] absent a reasonable allowance of time." Thus, Attorney Mirza asks the court "for leave as it deems appropriate to comply with SCR 22.26."

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. SCR 22.26(1)(d) provides Attorney Mirza 15 days after the effective date of his suspension to make all arrangements for the temporary or permanent closing or winding up of his practice. In addition, SCR 22.26(1)(e) provides Attorney Mirza 25 days after the effective date of his suspension to file an affidavit with the OLR showing full compliance with his post-suspension obligations. Attorney Mirza has made no showing as to why he should not be expected to abide by these deadlines.
