Kapalczynski v. Krause-Kapalczynski, L.C.#2022FA1005

The court having considered the February 22, 2024 motion of Bonnie Mae Krause-Kapalczynski, pro se, for an extension of time to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' January 31, 2024 order;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Furthermore, the motion cannot be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because the underlying order from the court of appeals denied motions for relief pending appeal. This order is not reviewable by a petition for review because it does not constitute a final decision of the court of appeals. See In Interest of A.R., 85 Wis. 2d 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978).
