Kapalczynski v. Krause-Kapalczynski, L.C.#2022FA1005

The court having construed the "Appellant's Application to Extend Time to File Petition for Review with the Wisconsin Supreme Court – and – Request for Leave and Continuance until the Waukesha Circuit Court <u>and</u> Wisconsin Court of Appeals provides the Entire Record 'True' of Each Case No. on a USB with an Index # and to Provide Sufficient to [sic] Time to Prepare a Defense," as a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is dismissed. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. <u>First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou</u>, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Furthermore, the motion cannot be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because the subject of a petition for review must be a final decision of the court of appeals. <u>See In Interest of A.R.</u>, 85 Wis. 2d 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978). Briefing has not yet begun in the court of appeals; thus, the court of appeals has not yet rendered its final decision.
