You are hereby notified that the Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

No. 2024AP180 & 181 State v. J.S., L.C.#s 2022TP64 and 2022TP65

On May 14, 2024, Attorney Jill C. Vento, counsel for respondent-appellant-petitioner, J.S., filed a no-merit petition for review and appendix pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.32(4) regarding the court of appeals' April 16, 2024 decision. Along with the no-merit petition for review, counsel filed a motion for an extension of time for J.S. to file a supplemental petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.32(4)(a).

On May 23, 2024, J.S., pro se, submitted a document that this court construes to be a motion to extend the time in which to file a supplemental petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.32(4)(a). The court notes that J.S. failed to observe the confidentiality rules applicable to termination of parental rights cases by using her full name when the use of initials or a pseudonym is required. See Wis. Stat. § 809.81(1)(8).

IT IS ORDERED that the motions for an extension of time filed by Attorney Vento and J.S. are granted. J.S. shall have until September 3, 2024, to serve and file her supplemental petition for review pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.32(4)(a); and
