On June 28, 2024, the court of appeals issued a decision denying the petition for writ of habeas corpus filed by petitioner, Alden J. Brandl, pro se. On July 5, 2024, Mr. Brandl filed a motion for reconsideration of the court of appeals' decision. Subsequently, on July 12, 2024, Mr. Brandl filed a Notice of Appeal form regarding the court of appeals' decision. The court construes the Notice of Appeal form to be a nonconforming petition for review. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Notice of Appeal filed July 12, 2024 shall be construed to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for review shall be held in abeyance pending action by the court of appeals on the motion for reconsideration. Once the court of appeals has ruled on the motion for reconsideration, an order will be issued notifying the parties of the dates by which they will be required to make further filings. A date will be established by which defendant-appellant will be required to file a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4). A date will also be established for plaintiff-respondent, State of Wisconsin, to file a response to the petition for review.
