

You are hereby notified that the Court has entered the following order:

Nos. 2024AP69 & 70 State v. T.H., L.C.#s 2022TP163 & 164

The court has before it: (1) a petition for bypass filed by respondent-appellant-petitioner T.H.; and (2) a motion to stay filed by petitioner-respondent State of Wisconsin, in which the State asks this court "to hold [T.H.'s] appeals and [T.H.'s] Petition to Bypass in abeyance pending a decision from the Wisconsin Supreme Court in State v. H.C."

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for stay is granted in part. To the extent the State seeks a stay of "[T.H.]'s appeals," this court will take no action on the request given that the appellate briefing is complete and the court of appeals will not issue a decision while the bypass petition is pending. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60(3). To the extent that the State seeks a stay of the petition for bypass, that request is granted. The petition for bypass shall be held in abeyance pending this court's disposition of case no. 2023AP1950, State v. H.C. (petition for review granted on September 11, 2024).
