No. 2024XX898-CR State v. Turner, L.C.# 2018CF727

On October 23, 2024, this court received a letter filed by defendant Paul A. Turner, pro se, that asks the court to “accept this letter as the petition for review and grant 60 days to file supporting documents.” The letter appears to concern a September 23, 2024 order by the court of appeals. The court cannot construe the letter to be a timely but nonconforming petition for review because the subject of a petition for review must be the final decision of the court of appeals. In Interest of A.R., 85 Wis. 2d 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978). The court of appeals’ September 23, 2024 order denying Mr. Turner’s various pro se motions and allowing him until November 18, 2024, to file a notice of appeal or postconviction motion is not a final decision; i.e., it does not finally dispose of the case in the court of appeals. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on defendant Paul A. Turner’s letter filed October 23, 2024.
