The Supreme Court, on its own motion, has considered the advisability of amending its Internal Operating Procedures to update a reference to a state agency. In January 2007 the Wisconsin Legislature created the Wisconsin Government Accountability Board (G.A.B.) by merging the former State Elections Board and former State Ethics Board.¹

IT IS ORDERED that, effective the date of this order, IV.A. of the Wisconsin Supreme Court Internal Operating Procedures is amended to read:

A. Appointment Selection Committee

The Appointment Selection Committee (Committee) consists of the following 12 persons:
