Re: Supreme Court Rule Matter 06-04 and 06-04A, <u>In the matter of review of amendments to SCR 20:1.15</u>

Greetings,

On May 27, 2010, the Wisconsin Supreme Court further amended the trust account rule under Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 20:1.15 regarding alternative protection for advanced fees and the

exception for fee and cost advances by credit card. The amendments to SCR 20:1.15(b)(4m) and 20:1.15(e)(4)h. are effective January 1, 2011, but are subject to revision if the court receives comments and further proposed changes that would necessitate a public hearing in the fall of 2010. You are receiving this letter because you may have expressed an interest in this matter or you provided the court with valuable input on the petition.

A brief summary of the history of this rule petition (rule no. 06-04) begins in 2006. The Office of Lawyer Regulation and the State Bar of Wisconsin filed a joint petition on May 22, 2006, proposing certain modifications to the "trust account rule," SCR 20:1.15. On January 17, 2007, the court held a public hearing on rule petition number 06-04. On April 12, 2007, the court voted 6 to 1 to adopt the petition, with modifications. Justice Bradley dissented from that portion of the petition permitting alternative protection for advanced fees, SCR 20:1.15(b)(4m). The effective date of the amendments was July 1, 2007, and the court agreed to review the amendments in three years. On November 12, 2009, the court issued an order scheduling a review of the 2007 amendments and requested comments. On May 10, 2010, the court held an administrative conference. The court reviewed the rule amendments, considered the comments and proposed amendments received, and adopted the proposed amendments.
