To be eligible to take the written examination, candidates **must have** completed the two-day orientation. Candidates may sign up to take either the multiple choice test or the written language assessment or both. There is no fee for taking the multiple choice test. Test candidates who are registering for the written language assessment, must send in an application form and \$45 fee by the deadline.

## 2013 Oral Testing Schedule

To be eligible to take the oral examination, candidates **must have** passed either the multiple choice examination or the written language assessment or both. Pre-registration for the oral test is required as walk-ins are not allowed. The complete oral test takes one hour and slots are held on a first-come first-serve basis.
